PRESBYTERIAN MUTUAL SOCIETY

The PMS Administrator is seeking nominations from representatives within certain classes of creditors and will arrange for a postal vote so that a committee can be constituted. While shareholders are not strictly entitled to sit on the creditor's committee, the Administrator is seeking nominations from shareholders for a representative who will sit on the committee as an observer.

Each nominee will require 10 persons to support the nomination.

Any church member with investment in PMS who wish to nominate a representative to the Creditors' Committee, please get in touch with Chin Kwang Lau.

The function of a creditors' committee is to "assist the administrator in discharging his functions, and act in relation to him in such manner as may be agreed from time to time". In practice, a creditors' committee in an administration does not act in an advisory capacity but as a "sounding board" for an Administrator in relation to the views of creditors. Whilst the Administrator of the Society does have to provide a creditors' committee with information about the exercise of his functions, it is important to bear in mind that there may from time to time be other legal obligations on the Administrator which prevent him from discussing certain aspects of the administration.
